**Year 10 HeppSY Mobile Classroom visit to Outwood Academy Adwick
on Wednesday 13th November 2019.**

The HeppSY Project is an exciting project that is part of the National Collaborative Outreach Programme with an aim to increase the number of young people progressing to Higher Education. As part of the project, Outwood Academy Adwick has invited the HeppSY Mobile Classroom (HeppSY Bus) to visit our Year 10 students on Wednesday 13th November 2019.

What is the HeppSY Mobile Classroom?

Education chiefs from the Higher Education Progression Partnership South Yorkshire (HeppSY+) have launched a mobile classroom (the HeppSY bus) with Chris Stead, Senior Activity Officer, the National Collaborative Outreach Programme (NCOP) and a number of Graduate Interns from Sheffield Hallam University.

The team are touring the region giving talks and workshops on board the double-decker bus to students from 38 secondary schools and colleges.

On the day, the bus will be parked in the academy staff car park. Some of the students from Year 10 will be invited to take part in sessions on the bus throughout Periods 1 to 5. They will have a sticker in their planner letting them know which session they should attend.

The sessions will cover 'Career Knowledge' focusing on Case Studies, Degree Pathways and Job Profiles.

We hope that the students find these mobile classroom sessions extremely useful, helping them to prepare for their future.
