Y13 Remote Masterclasses 7-30 June 2021

Dear parent/carer,

Upon reflection of our Year 13 provision, from Monday 7 June 2021, all students will move to remote learning with a focus on providing 'step up' provision in preparation for Post 18 progression routes. The programme will have three distinct aims:

1. To provide students with the opportunity to **deepen their understanding and knowledge** of subjects they intend to study at University
2. To **enrich students'** understanding of the Post 18 steps including University life & courses
