I hope that you are well and that you are carefully adjusting to a form of normality as lockdown is gradually eased.

As young people, you have faced a range of challenges and restrictions brought about by this pandemic which you could not have prepared for. From what I have witnessed you have responded admirably, especially as the academy closed with such short notice.

Due to schools being closed for the past 4 months the exam boards have developed a system to provide you with grades, based on the work you completed prior to lockdown and on the predictions provided by the academy.

Over the past few weeks I have been hearing about Year 13 students next steps, which include University, apprenticeships and the start of careers. If you are still unsure about what you would like to do next, please do get in touch. We will be happy to support you.

The year 13 results day is scheduled for Thursday 13th August

In order to prioritise student and staff safety we have established a range of control measures that we must strictly follow, as detailed below;

- Results will be collected from the OIE main hall. Each student will have an allocated time to collect results, arriving via the Tenter Baulk Lane gate. Your personalised offer to attend and plans are detailed below.
- We have devised that a small group of students will be allocated each time-slot, at each venue and one family member may accompany each student. On arrival it is important that social distancing and pathway directions are adhered to.
- On arrival you will complete a simple results collection form; given your own pen & form.
- Each student will then receive a personalised bag including their results
- Specialised staff will be on hand to support results and destinations, some in person and some via virtual technology

We understand that results day is usually an emotional occasion with a sense of release following the hard work and effort you have put in to reach this stage. Whilst we are not able to offer our usual experience for results day, I hope this more measured and controlled approach will offer support, whilst maintaining important safety measures. As part of this we also have to ensure that we do not have groups of people congregating and coming together in larger groups, and this is why we have staggered sessions and across multiple zones. We are also conscious of supporting our community and ask that you adhere to self-distancing in and out of the academy to keep everyone safe.
